- Good Academic Standing with his/her academic institution

4. Applications will be considered in their entirety based on academic performance, future goals and professional references.

5. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of race, gender, ethnic origin, religious affiliations or marital status.

6. Please complete the application form completely and legibly.

7. Essay should be double-spaced on separate typewritten sheets with a header to include your name, phone number and email address.
