2. Up to two scholarships will be awarded to the most qualified candidate(s) who have completed and submitted all required materials on time. Total amount of scholarships awarded not to exceed \$1000.

3. Qualified candidates must be:

- Senior PA student (4th/5th year students)
- Good Academic Standing with his/her academic institution

4. Applications will be considered in their entirety based on academic performance, future goals and professional references.

5. Scholarships will be awarded regardless of race, gender, ethnic origin, religious affiliations or marital status.

6. Please complete the application form completely and legibly.

7. Please submit the essay, should be double-spaced on separate typewritten sheets with a header to include your name, phone number and email address.

8. Review all scholarship materials for completeness prior to submission.

Provide evidence of your academic achievement through the Spring Semester of 2018 (to include entire academic transcript up to spring 2018). This may take the form of either an unofficial transcript or a copy of grade report signed by the director of your PA Program faculty.

**Part IV: Essay**

On separate pages, please answer the following two (2) questions succinctly with at least 250 words but no more than 500 words each.

1. Recently, there has been a lot of emphasis on value based care for medical reimbursement. How can you as a Physician Assistant help provide value based care to your patients? Please provide 2 things you could do to help your practice succeed.
2. What makes you unique and deserving of this scholarship over all other applicants? How will you use your scholarship funds?
